PAPERHANGING INSTRUCTIONS

PLEASE BE AWARE

THIS PRODUCT USES A NON-WOVEN BASE PAPER AND IT IS PREFERABLE, WHEN HANGING, FOR THE DECORATOR TO PASTE THE WALL RATHER THAN THE PAPER.

IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PAPERHANGER TO CHECK THAT THIS WALLPAPER IS CORRECT AND, DURING HANGING, TO CHECK THAT THERE ARE NO VISIBLE PROBLEMS.

AFTER HANGING THREE DROPS, THE WALLPAPER SHOULD BE INSPECTED, THE DECISION TO CONTINUE HANGING AFTER THREE DROPS IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE DECORATOR.

WE WILL NOT ACCEPT ANY CLAIM FOR WALLPAPER HUNG IN EXCESS OF THREE DROPS.

This is a quality wallpaper and to achieve the best results the hanging instructions need to be followed. The walls MUST be prepared correctly. This is particularly important when using foil papers.

A traditional style ready mixed tub paste should be used. Cellulose or powder pastes MUST NOT be used as they could cause surface staining or adhesion problems. We recommend the use of Cole & Son Tub Paste or Beeline Ready Mixed Vinyl Adhesive for this particular wallpaper.

Deep coloured wallpapers may need their edges coloured, with a slightly lighter tone of chalk or pastel, to prevent white edges showing.

Care should be taken not to crease the paper when folded. If possible use a felt covered roller rather than a brush for smoothing. Avoid squeezing paste out at the joints and make sure that no paste gets onto the smoothing roller. Trim tops and bottoms of the lengths with paperhanger's shears or with a sharp knife and a straight edge. No paste should be allowed to come into contact with the surface of the paper, and hands should be kept clean and dry.

ALWAYS CHECK WHICH WAY UP THE DESIGN IS BEFORE HANGING

Not all wallpapers are wipeable; some papers can be damaged by moisture (paste, water etc.) on the surface.

Check all wallpaper within 14 days of receipt, should paper be considered faulty, please notify your supplier. We cannot accept any responsibility after the paper has been hung.
